Many people think of rough sleepers when they think of homelessness but rough sleepers represent only about 1% of the homeless population.

**1966**

Shelter was set up to do what the Government, housing bodies and local agencies were failing to do: prevent bad housing and homelessness from taking a terrible toll on people's lives.

**1986**

Trinity Winchester was founded to support the significant numbers of homeless and badly housed people in Winchester.

**2006**

**Homelessness is still with us and there are massive discrepancies in life-chances between the wealthy and the have-nots. Help for those on the margins is needed more than ever.**

**Trinity Winchester** aims to support homeless people and those at risk of homelessness as well as other vulnerable and isolated members of society.

**The Trinity Centre** is an open access drop-in day centre.

**Trinity Women's Centre** improves access to services for vulnerable women and offers opportunities for change.

**Trinity's Floating Support** service provides advice and support to people in temporary accommodation and those with tenancy problems.
